A presentation summarizing the feasibility study on five low-head dams in the Lower Olentangy Watershed will be featured at the Friends of the Lower Olentangy Watershed (FLOW) regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

This feasibility study evaluates improvements that can be made to dams containing sanitary sewer crossings to improve water quality, habitat and recreational use of the Olentangy River. This study is a partnership project involving the City of Columbus Department of Public Utilities, FLOW, Ohio EPA and the Ohio Department of Natural Resources.
