Recognizing Friends of the Lower Olentangy Watershed

Whereas the Olentangy River was designated as a State Scenic River in 1973; and

Whereas the river and surrounding lands provide habitat for numerous species of birds, mussels, and fish, many of which are endangered; and

Whereas paddlers, hikers, cyclists, campers, anglers, and bird watchers all take advantage of extensive recreational opportunities on and around the river; and

Whereas Friends of the Lower Olentangy Watershed (“FLOW”) has worked to protect the lower Olentangy River since 1997 through volunteer engagement and outreach activities; and


Whereas FLOW completed several projects in 2014 to protect the Olentangy River, including planting 1,600 seedlings, constructing butterfly gardens, planting rain gardens, removing invasive honeysuckle from area parks, and performing multiple river clean-ups;
